

## MATH: NUMBERS 0-20




Count the Numbers and say "BOO!" when you see a ghost!

Say the Alphabet and say "BOO!" when you see a ghost!

Count a number of objects from 0-10 and begin to associate them with a written numeral.

Name written numerals 0-10.

## INSTRUCTIONS & TIPS

#### Prep Instructions

Print, laminate, cut and trim all ghost cards, number cards, Uppercase letter cards, and Lowercase letter cards.

#### How to Play:Letters

Whole Group Letters-Use the letters your class is ready for in either uppercase or lowercase.

Place the ghosts in a few places in the deck of letter cards.

Instruct the kids that "We are going to name some letters today, when you see the letter, say the letter...but there are ghosts hidden amongst the letters. When you see a ghost, say "BOO!", then go back to saying the letters as you see them.

Small Group Letters-Use the letters your class is ready for in either upper or lowercase.

Place the ghosts in a few places in the deck of lettercards.

Instruct the kids that "We are going to flip these letter cards over one at a time., When you see a letter, say the letter...but there are ghosts hidden amongst the letters. When you see a ghost, say "BOO!", then go back to saying the letters as you see them.

#### How to Play

Whole Group Numbers-Use the number order your class is ready for-0-5 for 3-4's, 0-10 for Pre-K, 0-20 for Kindergarten (just an example)

Place the ghosts in a few places in the deck of cards.


